### **Responsibilities**

- Safely operate various farm related equipment, driving of heavy horses with sleighs/wagons with general public &/or organized groups (school, youth etc.) riding on the sleigh/wagon during special events, weekend, holidays, & seasonal events.
- Barn chores & animal care
- General upkeep & maintenance of the park, buildings, equipment, facilities & grounds.
- Clean park interpretive facilities including washrooms, vault toilets and other public use areas
- Perform duties and ensure assigned employees & volunteers (if applicable) work in accordance with Conservation Halton's Safety policy and procedures and with the Occupational Health and Safety Act and its regulations;
- Perform other duties as required to contribute to the team effort and achieve the objectives of the department and Conservation Halton.

- Experience feeding and caring of farm animals
- Team player capable of self-directed, independent work
- Strong problem solving and time management skills
